Section 2.Hazards Identification

Clear pale blue liquid; no odor.

CAUTION! Slightly toxic by ingestion and body tissue irritant. Target organs: Liver, kidneys, lungs, spleen This material is considered hazardous by the OSHA Hazard Communication Standard (29 CFR 1910.1200).

Section 3.First Aid Measures

Eyes: Immediately flush eyes with excess water for 15 minutes, lifting lower and upper eyelids occasionally.

Skin: Immediately flush skin with excess water for 15 minutes while removing contaminated clothing.

Ingestion: Call Poison Control immediately. Rinse mouth with cold water. Give victim 1-2 cups of water or milk to drink. Induce vomiting immediately. Inhalation: Remove to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration

Section 4. Fire Fighting Measures

Nonflammable solution. When heated to decomposition, emits acrid fumes.

Protective equipment and precautions for firefighters: Use foam or dry chemical to extinguish fire. 0 0 Firefighters should wear full fire fighting turn-out gear and respiratory protection (SCBA). Cool container with water spray. Material is not sensitive to mechanical impact or static discharge.

Storage: Store in General Storage Area [Green Storage] with other items with no specific storage hazards. Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated, locked store room away from incompatible materials.
