Section 3.First Aid Measures

Description of first aid measures:

The symptoms resulting from intoxication can appear after exposure, therefore, in case of doubt, seek medical attention for direct

exposure to the chemical product or persistent discomfort, showing the SDS of this product.

By inhalation:

This product is not classified as hazardous through inhalation. However, in case of intoxication symptoms it is recommended to





remove the person affected from the area of exposure, provide clean air and keep at rest. Request medical attention if symptoms persist.

By skin contact:

This product is not classified as hazardous when in contact with the skin. However, in case of skin contact it is recommended to

remove contaminated clothes and shoes, rinse the skin or if necessary shower the affected person thoroughly with cold water

and neutral soap. In case of serious reaction consult a doctor.

By eye contact:

Rinse eyes thoroughly with water for at least 15 minutes. If the injured person uses contact lenses, these should be removed

unless they are stuck to the eyes, in which case removal could cause further damage.

In all cases, after cleaning, a doctor should be consulted as quickly as possible with the SDS for the product.

By ingestion/aspiration:

Do not induce vomiting, but if it does happen keep the head down to avoid aspiration.

Keep the person affected at rest. Rinse out

the mouth and throat, as they may have been affected during ingestion.

Most important symptoms and effects, both acute and delayed:

Indication of any immediate medical attention and special treatment needed:

Section 4. Fire Fighting Measures

Extinguishing media:

Product is non-flammable under normal conditions of storage, handling and use. In the case of combustion as a result of improper

handling, storage or use preferably use polyvalent powder extinguishers (ABC powder), in accordance with the Regulation on fire

protection systems. IT IS NOT RECOMMENDED to use tap water as an extinguishing agent.

Special hazards arising from the substance or mixture:

As a result of combustion or thermal decomposition reactive sub-products are created that can become highly toxic and,

consequently, can present a serious health risk.

Advice for firefighters:

Isolate leaks provided that there is no additional risk for the people performing this task.

used against potential contact with the spilt product . Evacuate the area and keep out those who do not have protection.

Environmental precautions:

This product is not classified as hazardous to the environment. Keep product away from drains, surface and underground water.

Methods and material for containment and cleaning up:

It is recommended: Absorb the spillage using sand or inert absorbent and move it to a safe place. Do not absorb in sawdust or other combustible absorbents.

A.- Precautions for safe manipulation

Comply with the current legislation concerning the prevention of industrial risks. Keep containers hermetically sealed. Control

spills and residues, destroying them with safe methods (section 6). Avoid leakages from the container. Maintain order and

cleanliness where dangerous products are used.
